

## GARMENT WASHING INSTRUCTIONS

Pendle kits are manufactured from top quality materials. All fabrics undergo stringent quality tests to ensure durability and washability. They will give many years of service if properly cared for.

# Always follow the washing instructions on the garment care label and wash all printed garments inside out.

# Football Kits

First wash - Always wash shirts, shorts and socks separately to remove any surface dye.

Do not leave kits folded or bundled together for any length of time whilst damp or soiled as this may cause dye transfer or mildew. Remove excess mud by pre soaking in cool water with detergent (no stain remover) as soon as possible after use to avoid stains from setting.

Garments may discolour due to staining by substances such as grass & mud which may not be removed entirely by washing alone. Treat stubborn stains directly with an appropriate stain remover & rinse the garment with cold water before washing. Take care not to use stain remover on printed transfers applied to the garment as this may affect the quality of the print. Do not add stain remover to the washing machine. Some of the toughest stains may require more than one treatment especially on light coloured garments.

Do not over load the washing machine and wash light and dark colours separately.

Do not wash above the temperature stated on the garment care label. (Always use a synthetic wash)

Do not use fabric softener.

Tumble Dry Cool.

Never iron printed motifs.

### Showerproof and Waterproofs Garments.

Rainsuits and Waterproofs do not require regular washing, instead wipe clean with a damp cloth. If necessary wash inside out on a 30°C synthetic wash. Garments may need to be retreated after washing.

Do not use fabric softener as this will affect any waterproof coating.

#### Do not use stain remover on printed transfers applied to garments.

Do not tumble dry.

Never iron printed motifs.

### Tracksuits & Clubwear


Wash inside out, on a 30°C synthetic wash.

Tumble Dry Cool.

Do not use fabric softener as this will affect any moisture wicking property of the fabric.

### Do not use stain remover on printed transfers applied to garments.

Never iron printed motifs.
